

Chapter 13: The Lueck Family Tree

Maternal Lineage of Mary Bloedow Kuehl

Tracing history through Mary's Mother Auguste Tugenreich Lueck

Much of the book to this point has been about the paternal ancestors of Grandma Mary Bloedow Kuehl, that is, relatives of her father Ferdinand. Now we'll turn to Grandma Mary's maternal ancestors, that is, relatives of her mother Auguste. Auguste's maiden name was Lueck. We're grateful to Otto F Bloedow for his painstaking research digging through historical records to gather this information.

THE LUECKS - FAMILY OF AUGUSTE LUECK BLOEDOW WHO WAS MOTHER OF MARY BLOEDOW KUEHL

The mother of Mary Bloedow Kuehl was Augusta, born into the family Lueck.

Auguste's parents were Wilhelmina Schlabritz(ke) and Gottlieb Lueck. It is not known where Gottlieb or Wilhelmina were born, where they lived, or where they died. Likely it was in the village of Klein Silber or the immediate areas of Kreis Arnswalde (Province of Brandenburg) or Kreis Saatzig (Province of Pomerania).

Wilhelmina Schlabritz(ke) and Gottlieb were the maternal grandparents of Mary Bloedow Kuehl. The Luecks had three children – Herman, Auguste, and Wilhelmina. Auguste was the mother of our grandmother Mary. Then sometime between 1846 and 1856 Wilhelmina Schlabritz(ke) died. And this is all we know about Mary Bloedow Kuehl's maternal grandmother Wilhelmina.

Gottlieb remarried, this time to another Wilhelmina - Wilhelmina Lutlow. As far as we know, their first child was Amelia, a half sister to Augusta. Apparently there were more children from this second marriage. From Amelia's obituary we learn that Amelia had four brothers, not named. But if she had more siblings, (half-siblings to Augusta) we simply don't know. Regarding Gottlieb,

Schlabritz or Schlabritzke?

The name of Auguste's mother in some documents is spelled "Schlabritz. In other documents a "ke" is added at the end - Schlabritzke. **In this book we will be using the name Schlabritz(ke)** - a compromise between the two.

Various spellings of names adds confusion to genealogy research



You'd think you can count on a person's name being permanent. Well, in genealogy research you learn that "It isn't necessarily so." Here are examples of name variations in the Lueck family.

FATHER OF AUGUSTE - IS IT GOTLIEB OR CARL?

At one time a member of Auguste's step-family who lives in the St James, MN area mentioned to Otto F Bloedow that Augusta's father was known in their family as Carl ... to which she added "Carl with a 'C'". In Germany the spelling would have been with a "K", as in Karl. It's possible that if Auguste's father was using the name Karl, he would have Americanized it to Carl.

Interestingly enough, Auguste named not just one of her sons Carl, but two. They being **Carl** "William" Frederick Wilhelm Bloedow, and **Carl** "Charlie" Gustav Bloedow. And both men's names are spelled with a "C".

As this book goes to print, there are no known documents nor gravestone for a Carl, Gottlieb Carl, nor Carl Gottlieb Lueck. However, what is recorded as "father" on obituaries and death records of Auguste, her brother Herman, and step sister Amelia is the name "Gottlieb". We suggest future genealogists might do well to research him under both the name of Gottlieb and Carl.

In this book we will be using the name "Gottlieb Lueck" as this is the name given by the families for the obituaries and death records for Auguste, Herman and Amelia.

HOW IS LUECK SPELLED IN AMERICA?

The German alphabet includes vowels with an umlaut. The umlaut, two dots aligned horizontally above a vowel, slightly alters the sound of the vowel. The umlaut is not used in America. Rather, the correct substitution is to follow the vowel with the letter "e". K^ühl (with umlaut u) becomes Kuehl. Bl^ödow (with umlaut o) becomes Bloedow. L^ück (with umlaut u) becomes Lueck.

In the obituaries or death certificates of Auguste and her siblings, we find various spellings for the name Lueck.

Herman J.J's last name is **Luck**. His father is said to be Gottlieb **Luck**.

Auguste Christine Tugendreich is **Lueck** Bloedow. Her father's name is spelled as Gottlieb **Lue**.

The newspaper obituary for Wilhelminna Nickel (no maiden name given) writes her father's name as **Luck**.

And Amelia's given name is Johanna Emilie Albertine **Lue** Grabow. Her father's name appears as Gottlieb **Lueck**.

According to Vernon Bloedow, Gotlieb is buried in a cemetery near St James, Blue Earth County, MN.

Although the mother of Auguste, Herman, and Wilhelmina is not the same mother as Amelia's, each is born as a Lueck.

Sometime between 1846 and 1856 Gotlieb remarried and fathered at least Amelia. Family narrative indicates that Auguste's mother had died by the time her father came to America.


It was with the second wife Wilhelmina that Gotlieb would have come to America. Their daughter Amelia, 26, arrived in America in 1879, as did Wilhelmina Lueck (sister of Auguste) with her family. It's likely, though not confirmed, that Wilhelmina and Amelia (Auguste's sister and half sister) traveled together, arriving in America on the same ship, same date. Augusta's brother Herman (as a single man) stepped foot on American soil in April, 1869.

We can only imagine the cheers and tears of joy when upon her arrival in Springfield Auguste was reunited with her sister Wilhelmina, brother Herman, her half-sister Amelia, and likely even her father Gotlieb. What a welcoming that must have been.

Gotlieb Marries Wilhelmina Twice

After Auguste's mother died, her father Gotlieb married again. The first wife was Wilhelmina Schlabritz/ke, the second wife Wilhelmina Lutlow. Both were Wilhelmina.

Wilhelmina #2 would never know if when her husband endearingly whispered "Wilhelmina" into her ear he was having a memory lapse and thinking of his first wife.

Our Great-Grandmother Augusta's brother Herman, from Klein Silber, served in the Prussian military in 1864 – 1868. Augusta's husband Ferdinand also served in that war. Ferdinand and Herman are brothers-in-law from the same small town ... it's likely they may have been in the same unit, serving in the Prussian military together.

Great Grandmother Auguste's Middle Name of Tugenreich could be a Family Name

An observation by Otto F Bloedow: Mary Bloedow Kuehl's niece Elenora Bloedow had a middle name of Tugenreich – same as our Great- Grandmother Auguste. [She was christened as Auguste Christine Tugendreich Lueck] This leads one to believe - but-not-proven – that Tugenreich was a family name from one side or the other given to Great-Grandmother Auguste Bloedow Lueck.

Johanna Emilie Albertine, known as Amelia

Johanna Emile Albertine went by her middle name Emilie, spelled Amelia. As if solving the mysteries of family lineage isn't already a challenge, this is enough to lead an historian down a few blind alleys.
